
## Methodology

- 1005 voters aged 21 and above were interviewed via telephone
- The survey respondents are from all states across Peninsular Malaysia
- Voters were selected through random stratified sampling method along the lines of ethnicity, gender, age and parliament constituencies.
- All of the constituencies (12 states and 165 parliament constituencies) were surveyed and the selection of the respondents is proportional with respect to the population in each parliament constituency.
- Respondents were interviewed in their own language of preferences
- Survey margin of error estimated at ±3.09%
- The survey was conducted on 7<sup>th</sup> 20<sup>th</sup> March 2014

Note: Total percentages presented may or may not add up to 100% due to rounding up of figures.






Q: Do you feel things in this country are going in the right direction, or do you feel things have gotten on the wrong track?

#### Right versus Wrong direction





#### Right direction across Ethnicity

















Sentiments over income and prices have become negative but remain steady on jobs and business opportunities



#### % respondents expressing "favorable"









#### Satisfaction versus Dissatisfaction










Perception towards Government across Ethnicity % respondents expressing "happy"





Perception towards Barisan Nasional across Ethnicity % respondents expressing "happy"






