Malaysia State Elections 2023 Voter Survey Highlights

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Methodology & Respondent Profiles

A total of 6,179 voters aged 18 and above were interviewed via telephone in Selangor, Kedah, Penang, N.Sembilan, Kelantan and Terengganu on the following corresponding dates.

> Selangor : 26/7 - 11/8Negeri Sembilan : 03/7 - 14/7Penang : 02/8 - 04/8;

> > 10/08 - 11/08

Kedah: 12/7 - 02/8Kelantan: 04/8 - 08/8Terengganu: 08/8 - 09/8

 Voters were selected through random stratified sampling method along the lines of ethnicity, gender, age groups and state assembly constituencies.

- Respondents were interviewed in their own language of preference
- Survey margin of error for each survey is included in the table.
- The survey conducted via computer assisted telephone interviews and a small proportion of minority voters (in Selangor) were interviewed via a representative online panel.

Our surveys in Kedah, Penang, Terengganu and Kelantan and Terengganu focused only on the Malay electorate.





Perceived Direction of the State




Q: Considering the condition in the state today, would you say that things are heading in the right direction or wrong direction?




Perceived Direction of the State




Satisfaction with Federal Govt Performance




Satisfaction with Federal Govt Performance


Satisfaction with State Govt Performance




Q: How satisfied or dissatisfied are you with the performance of the ... State Government at present?


Chief Minister Performance






