




Methodology & Respondent Profile

- ✓ 2520 respondents aged between 18 to 30 years old were interviewed via telephone (fixed and mobile lines)
- ✓ The survey respondents are from all states across Malaysia.
- ✓ Respondents were selected through random stratified sampling method along the lines of ethnicity, gender, age and states.
- ✓ The selection of the respondents is proportional with respect to the population in each parliament constituency.
- ✓ Respondents were interviewed in their own language of preferences
- ✓ Survey margin of error estimated at ±1.95%
- ✓ The survey was conducted on 19 February 20 March 2021.








Views on the Country's Direction

- ✓ Youths hold mixed views on the direction of the country; are divided between right (46%) and wrong direction (42%)
 - The main reason of right direction is due to administration (17.6%) and leadership (11.6%)
 - The main reason for wrong direction is mainly due to concerns towards political instability(24.7%) and negative economic conditions (20.9%)
- ✓ Biggest challenges for Malaysia as seen by the youth is primarily the Economy (45.4%) and the Covid-19 Pandemic (23.6%)






Outlook and Perceived Prospects

- ✓ The main issues and needs of the youths are mostly economics related especially financial situation and employment opportunities
- ✓ Only one-half say they have what it takes to make ends meet
- ✓ The main aspirations of the youth relates to having a good family, financially stable and performing well at studies and work
- ✓ Vast majority believe that hard work rather than networks will bring them long term success.
- ✓ Vast majority of the youths are confident and optimistic on their future prospects and their ability to achieve their goals








Social Mobility: Networking vs Talent











Interest in politics & Top 5 Source of Information about Politics






Q: How interested are you in politics?

Q: From where did you know about politics?













Ethnic vs National Identity






